

USEFUL INFORMATION FOR THE ACQUISITION OF CREDITS FOR LANGUAGE SKILLS AND ABILITIES – BACHELOR’S DEGREE IN CIVIL ENGINEERING (L7)

Since the academic year 2026/27, the educational offer plan of the CdS in Civil Engineering provides for the attribution of credits in two different TAFs: **3 CFU belong to TAF E (“Per la prova finale e la lingua straniera” – art. 10 c. 5 l. c → “Per la conoscenza di almeno una lingua straniera” → “Knowledge of other EU language”)** and **3 CFU in TAF F (“Ulteriori attività formative” – art. 10 c. 5 l. d → “Ulteriori conoscenze linguistiche” → “Further language skills”)**

Before providing useful operational indications for the acquisition of ECTS credits in the aforementioned TAFs, it should be noted that in accordance with the provisions of the Course Regulations, as part of the admission requirements and the verification of initial preparation (art. 4 c.4), freshmen are required to have knowledge of the English language at a level of B2, showing appropriate certification of language knowledge or demonstrating that they come from a country for which English is the mother tongue. Any certification must be issued by bodies belonging to the list of certifying bodies recognized by AICLU (check [list](#) on UniME “Centro Linguistico di Ateneo” website) or by MIUR (check [list](#) on MIUR website). In the same paragraph, it is clarified that students with a level of knowledge of the English language lower than B2 will be required to carry out training activities for the acquisition of language skills.

That said, it should be noted that the acquisition of the CFU in the respective TAF was clarified by a resolution of the Council of the Degree Course in Civil Engineering in the meeting of 15/04/2026.

In particular, possible scenarios have been specified:

1. Students with adequate B2 English knowledge certificate:
 - a. Foreign students: students will be able to acquire, as part of the training course, 3 credits related to **any language of the European Union** as part of **TAF E** (Knowledge of other EU language) – excluding English and Italian -, through the study activity on the Unime Stone platform and 3 credits related to the knowledge of **the Italian language** within the **TAF F** (Further language skills), through activities provided on the Unime Stone platform.
 - b. Italian studenti: students will have the opportunity to acquire **6 credits for the study of other languages** - of which 3 dedicated to another EU language in TAF E - (excluding English and Italian) through training activities delivered on the Unime Stone platform.
2. Studenti without adequate B2 English knowledge certificate: students will have to make up for this debt by dedicating the **6 credits** for the study of other languages (3 credits in TAF E and 3 credits in TAF F) to the **study of the English language** level B2, using the Unime Stone platform, with subsequent exam.

For clarity, the various scenarios are summarized in the following summary table.

It should be clarified that any ex-post submission of appropriate certification of knowledge of the English language at level equal to or higher than B2 after enrolment does not guarantee automatic acquisition of the 6 CFU for language skills, but allows the transition from scenario no. 2 to scenario no. 1, referred to in the previous list.

All activities will be pre-evaluated by the Coordinator, or by his/her delegate, for the definition of the objectives on the Unime Stone platform and, subsequently, approved by the Council, before giving a mandate to the student secretariat for the attribution of the relative credits in the student's career.

Therefore, students must send an email to the Coordinator indicating their Name, Surname, *matricola* number, academic year of enrolment and year of enrolment as well as any certification of level equal to or higher than B2 used for admission to the Degree Course, specifying the languages selected for the planning of the related study objectives on the Unime Stone platform, in accordance with the details previously provided. The Coordinator, after the necessary checks, will communicate the type of objective to be activated on the Unime Stone platform.

NB: for students enrolled in previous cohorts (up to AY 2025/26), the rules are different. For students enrolled in the Degree Course in Civil Engineering (from AY 2022/23 to AY 2025/26), the study plan includes 6 CFU in TAF E (*“Per la prova finale e la lingua straniera” – art. 10 c. 5 l. c → “Per la conoscenza di almeno una lingua straniera” → “Knowledge of other EU language”*) relating to knowledge of the English language level B2. These credits can be acquired by passing the relevant exam on the Unime Stone platform or by presenting appropriate certification of knowledge of the English language issued by recognized bodies previously mentioned. Until AY 2021/22, TAF E CFU for English knowledge in TAF E were equal to 3 and the required level was B1. For further details and information, contact the Coordinator of the Course.
